

Summary of carboNZero certification:



Agility Logistics Limited

Agility Logistics Limited meets the requirements of carboNZero^{Cert™} certification having measured its greenhouse gas emissions in compliance with the requirements of ISO 14064-1:2006, committed to managing and reducing its emissions and neutralised its remaining unavoidable emissions through the cancellation of an appropriate number of verified carbon credits in respect of the operational activities of its organisation including the entire New Zealand operation but excluding freight that is contracted as part of its freight service



Introduction¹ – Agility Logistics Limited (Agility) is a subsidiary of Agility (International), which is a leading global provider of integrated logistics solutions. Agility (International) has more than 20,000 employees, with 450 offices in 100 countries around the world. Agility (NZ) has 68 employees in four offices located in Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch and Dunedin. Agility provides transportation and freight management services, collectively defined as their freight service in their emissions inventory. Agility offers their customers a personalised service and flexible solutions tailored to meet their individual business needs. Agility decided to become carbon neutral to reduce their organisation’s impact on the environment and respond to customers need. Potentially, this may in the future include measuring and off-setting freight emissions on behalf of their customers.

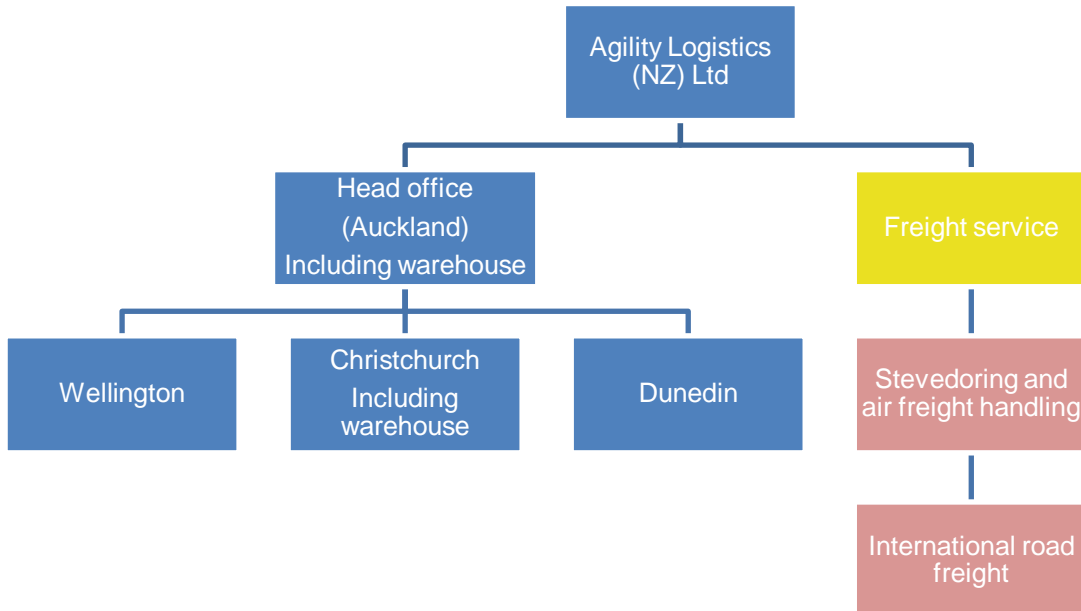
Boundary – The figure below shows the organisational structure used for describing Agility greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions inventory, and what business units were included in the carboNZero certification. The yellow business unit was included in the measurement for their inventory but was excluded from the offsets required for certification, while the blue units were excluded from the measurement. In addition to organisation certification, Agility offers a carboNZero freight service to clients on request. This would involve measuring and offsetting all freight associated emissions for that particular client, for the service which is supplied by external freight providers on behalf of Agility. In order to be able to offer a certified freight service, Agility have measured the freight emissions associated with their entire freight service, and disclose their organisational emissions in the context of this extended emissions inventory.

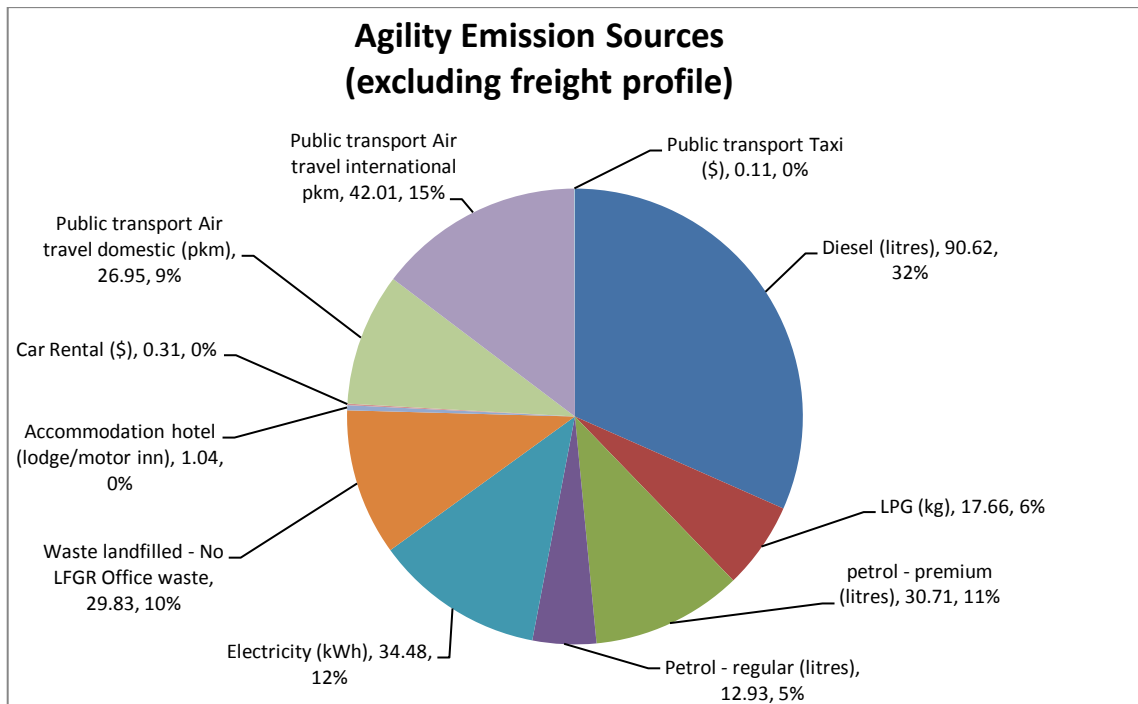
Consolidation approach –operational control

Base year – 01/01/2007 to 31/12/2007

Measurement period – 01/01/2010 to 31/12/2010

Emissions source inclusions – The diagram below shows the operational GHG emissions for Agility by emissions source. Agility's total emissions for this period including emissions associated with their freight service were 17,914 tonnes of CO₂e the operational emissions were 286.64 tonnes carbon dioxide equivalents (CO₂e) comprising 152 tonnes CO₂e Scope 1, 34 tonnes CO₂e Scope 2 and 100 tonnes CO₂e Scope 3 emissions.

Emissions source exclusions – Courier spend and domestic road freight have not been included due to no emissions factor being valid to calculate the emissions produced.

Emissions reduction commitments – Agility has developed a GHG emissions reduction plan. Some projects in this plan include:

- A move to more fuel efficient vehicles when replacing company vehicles and the commitment to reduce fuel consumption by 15 % over the next 5 years.
- To further reduce landfill waste and identify recycling opportunities to reduce landfill waste by 40% of base year volumes.
- Doing an annual office energy audit on the Auckland branch to reduce power consumption per person by 3%

Emissions reduction report against last year's plan – For the fourth emissions inventory the majority of emission sources have seen continued reductions, most notably (scope 1) petrol as Agility has continued to change its fleet to diesel. There has been an increase in international air travel (scope 3) due to a change in management structure and the requirement of NZ upper managers to report to the Australian regional office. This has increased Agility's international air travel by 21% in emissions compared to the 2009 report, also being the main contributor to the growth in scope 3 emissions.

Offset – 270 tonnes CO₂e from EBEX21 Native Forest Regeneration Projects (PFSI Compliance). Serial numbers 804311-804580 have been cancelled (or equivalent) on NZ Emissions Unit Register. Carbon credits were not required to offset emissions up to the 30th of June 2010 as all electricity was purchased from Meridian Energy.
