

Summary of carboNZero certification:



Project Litefoot Trust

Project Litefoot Trust meets the requirements of the carboNZero^{Cert™} certification having measured its greenhouse gas emissions in compliance with ISO 14064-1: 2006, committed to managing and reducing its emissions and neutralised its remaining unavoidable emissions through the cancellation of an appropriate number of verified carbon credits in respect of the operational activities of its organisation.



Introduction¹ – Project Litefoot is a charitable trust dedicated to inspiring New Zealanders to be environmental champions. Project Litefoot is led by seven top sportspeople. In view of this ambition, it is crucial that our organisation leads by example in measuring, managing and mitigating our own environmental impact, which is an immediate advantage to our company financially.

Boundary – The boundary for the preparation of Project Litefoot's greenhouse gas (GHG) inventory is for one site. All business activities have been included.

Consolidation approach – operational control

Base year – 01/04/2008 to 31/03/2009

Measurement period – 01/04/2010 to 31/03/2011

Emissions source inclusions – the diagram below shows the operational GHG emissions for Project Litefoot Trust by emissions source. Project Litefoot Trust's total emissions for this period were 6.56 tonnes carbon dioxide equivalents (tCO₂e) comprising:

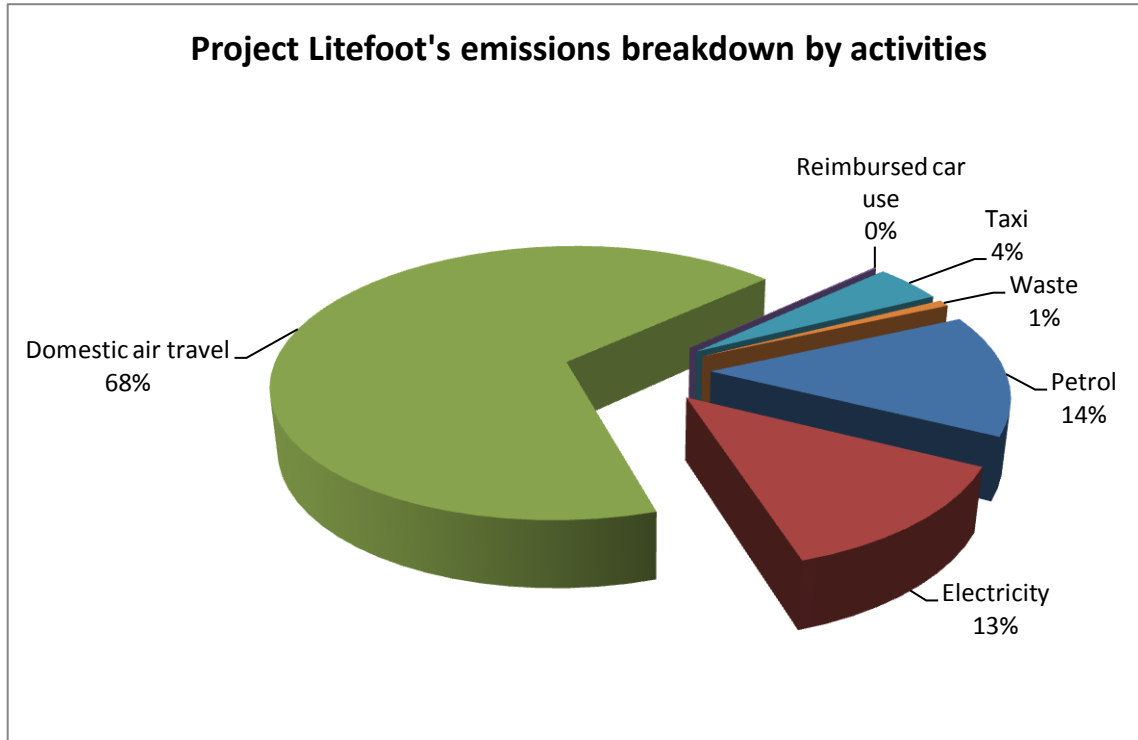
Scope 1: 0.92 tCO₂e

Scope 2: 0.84 tCO₂e

Scope 3: 4.80 tCO₂e

Emissions source exclusions – Couriers have been omitted from the inventory on the basis that all parcels weigh less than 2kg which is *de minimis*.

Emissions reduction commitments – Project Litefoot Trust has developed a GHG emissions reduction plan. Some projects in this plan include:

- Reduce emissions from Scope 1 fuel by 10% per FTE 2011-12 v 2010-11.
- Reduce emissions from Domestic Flying by 10% per FTE 2011-12 v 2010-11.
- Reduce overall emissions intensity per \$1m gross revenue by 10% 2011-12 v 2010-11

Emissions reductions and removals

Base year GHG emissions = 12.7 tCO₂e

GHG emissions calculated for this reporting period = 6.56 tCO₂e

Difference in GHG emissions = 6.14 tCO₂e

Offset – 7 tCO₂e. EBEX21 Native Forest Regeneration Projects (PFSI Compliance). Serial numbers 804581-804587 have been cancelled (or equivalent) on the New Zealand Emissions Unit Register.
