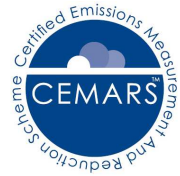


Summary of CEMARS certification:

Hunter's Wines (NZ) Limited meets the requirements of CEMARS® certification, having measured its greenhouse gas emissions in compliance with ISO 14064-:2006 and committed to reducing its emissions in respect of the operational activities of its organisation including the winery, vineyards, contract growers, and freight to the destination on the shipping note.



Introduction¹ – Hunter's Wines was established by Irishman, the late Ernie Hunter in 1979. Hunter's is one of New Zealand's best known wineries and a pioneer of the Marlborough wine industry. Led by the 'First lady of New Zealand wine' Jane Hunter, CNZM; O.B.E, Hunter's Wines have the reputation of consistently producing the highest quality wines year after year. Getting quality fruit from our vineyards is a very important step in the process, so everything we do is designed to protect the environment in which our grapes grow, in turn making our wine for you to drink. 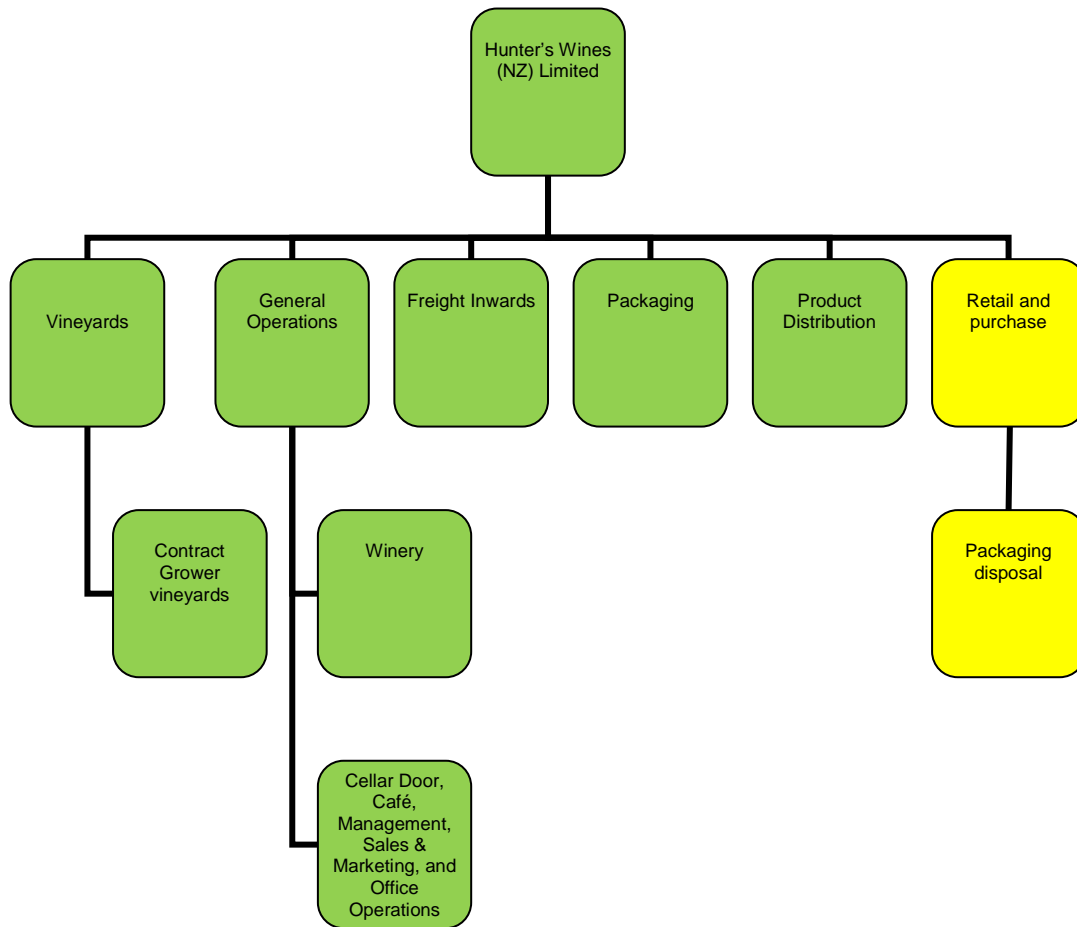

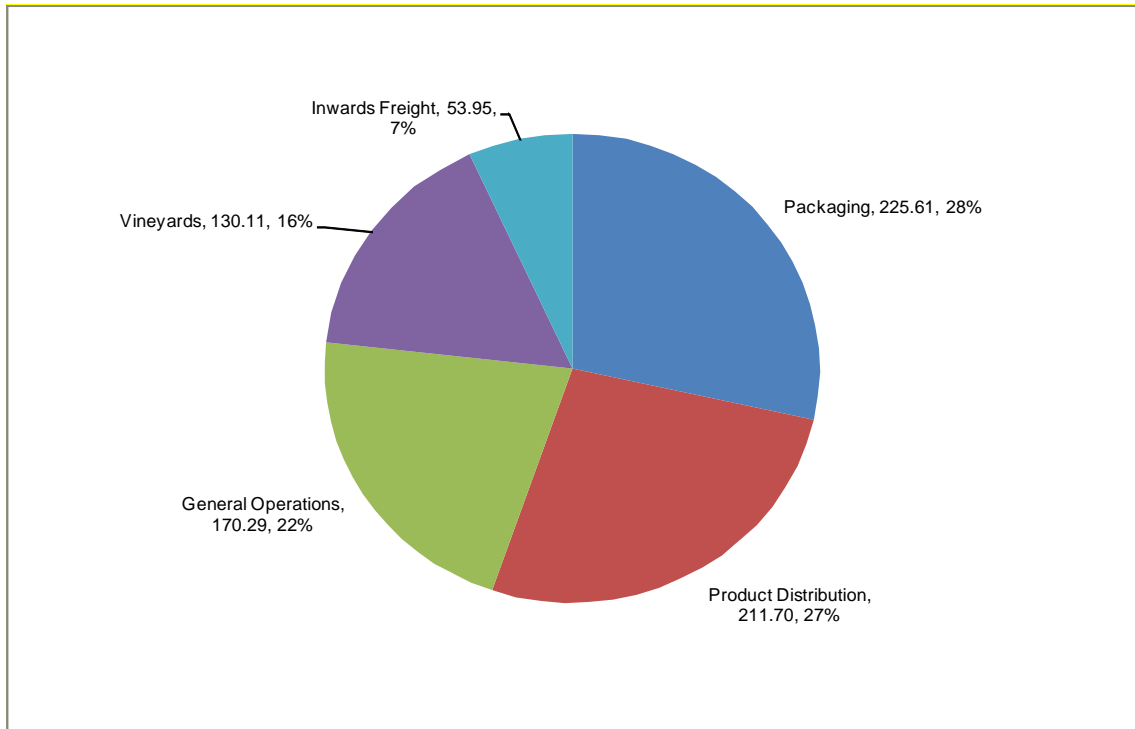
GHG emissions source inclusions – the Hunter's Wines GHG inventory reports diesel and petrol as Scope 1 emissions, electricity as Scope 2 emissions, freight (international air, international shipping, road, ferry, rail), international and domestic air travel, accommodation, contract growers, and embodied emissions in packaging materials as Scope 3 emissions.

GHG emissions profile – the diagram below shows the total GHG emissions for Hunter's Wines by business activity. Hunter's Wines total emissions were 792 tonnes of CO₂e for the 12 month period 01/07/2009 to 30/06/2010; of these, 566 tonnes of CO₂e were operational emissions, and 226 tonnes CO₂e were Scope 3 embodied emissions in packaging materials. The total emissions comprised 27 tonnes CO₂e Scope 1, 49 tonnes CO₂e Scope 2, and 490 tonnes CO₂e Scope 3 emissions in addition to the embodied emissions in packaging.

GHG emissions source exclusions – the following emissions sources were excluded:

- GHG emissions associated with the inwards goods supplied to the cafe and the winery have been excluded due to estimated emissions being below the *de minimis*.

GHG emissions reduction commitments – Hunter's Wines have developed a GHG emissions reduction plan. Some projects in this plan include:

- to reduce the weight of glass bottles and other packaging components
- to reduce electricity consumption, to be achieved by various actions
- to reduce diesel consumption at vineyards by more efficient use of machinery

Threshold of materiality – excluded emissions do not exceed 5% of the total footprint for organisation and product boundary stated.
