

Summary of carboNZero certification: Adventure South Ltd



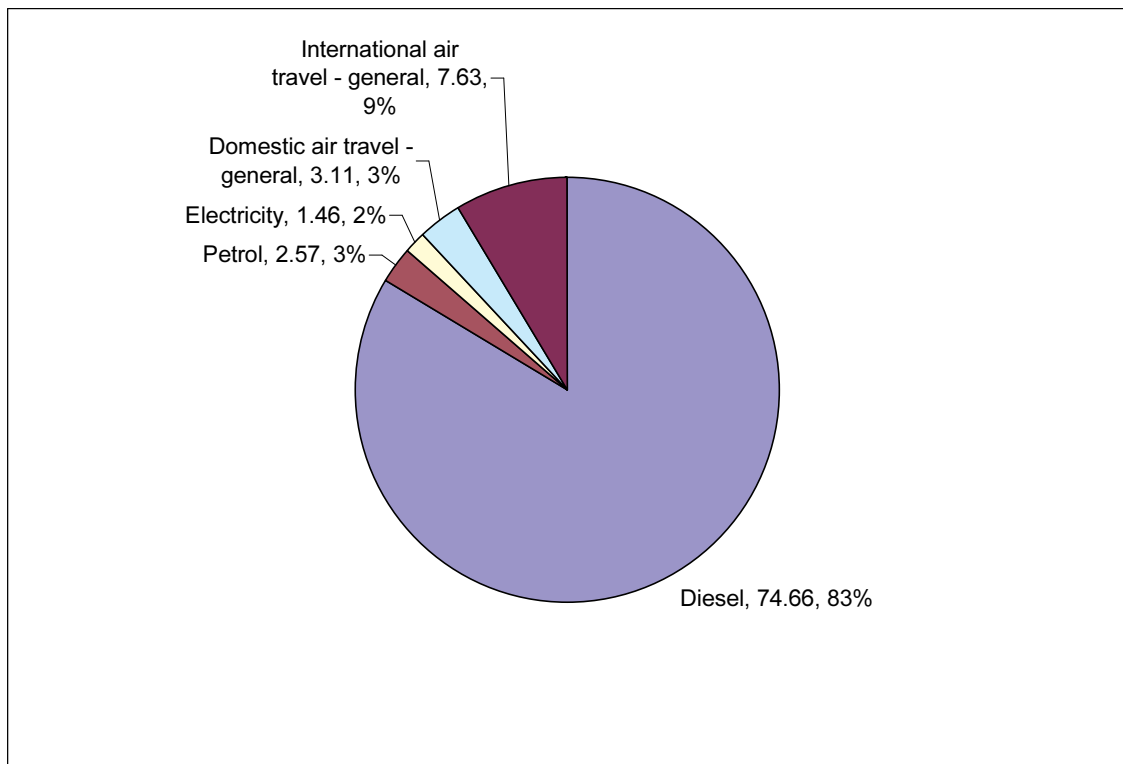
Introduction – Adventure South Ltd is an adventure tour operator that offers guided cycling, hiking and multi activity tours throughout New Zealand. Adventure South employs 5 full-time employees and 12 to 15 seasonal guides. The company owns and operates its own fleet of vehicles.

Boundary – Adventure South operates under one base facility and is privately owned. The table below clarifies what was included and excluded in the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions inventory.

Consolidation approach – Equity share.

GHG emissions profile – the diagram below shows the GHG emissions for Adventure South’s by business activity. Adventure South’s total emissions for this period were 89.43 tonnes carbon dioxide equivalents (CO₂e).

GHG emissions reduction commitments – Adventure South has developed a GHG emissions management plan. Some projects in this plan include:

- Encourage operators and contractors to adopt sustainable practices
- Reduce electricity through actions such as light bulb replacements and heating upgrades
- Reduce fuel consumption through driver training and reviewing vehicle upgrades
- Reduce staff commuting by personal vehicles by encouraging walking and cycling

Offset – 88 tonnes CO₂e. VERs¹ from PRE² landfill gas and windpower projects. Carbon credits were not required to offset Scope 3 purchased electricity (1.43 tonnes CO₂e) emissions because all electricity is purchased from Meridian Energy, which supplies carboNZero certified electricity.
