

Summary of carboNZero certification:

GreenWork Ltd

GreenWork Ltd meets the requirements of carboNZero^{Cert™} certification having measured its greenhouse gas emissions in compliance with ISO 14064-1, committed to managing and reducing its emissions and neutralised the remaining unavoidable emissions in respect of the operational activities of its organisation.



Introduction¹ – GreenWork provides property maintenance, landscaping and organic waste removal services in the Auckland area. We are committed to reducing our environmental impact and that of our clients. We realise the impacts that climate change will have on the environment so minimising our GHG emissions is an important part of what we do. We have been measuring our emissions since April 2009 and the major source of our emissions comes from our vehicle use. We are focusing on reducing our vehicle emissions per employee by 5% over the next 12 months. To achieve this we are taking steps to improve our job planning and transport logistics, carpooling where possible, keeping our vehicles well maintained and conducting our weekly safety and planning meetings by skype. For us this is just a start, we aim to constantly lessen our impacts and reduce our emissions over time. We have cancelled a total of 9 carbon credits and chosen to purchase the credits from renewable energy generation projects. We see renewable energy technology as a hugely positive step to combating climate change and are very pleased to support these projects. We look forward to a future where we do not have to rely on energy generated through fossil fuels.

Boundary – The boundary for the preparation of GreenWork Ltd's greenhouse gas (GHG) inventory is for one site. All business activities have been included.

Consolidation approach – Operational control.

Base year – 01/04/2009 to 31/03/2010

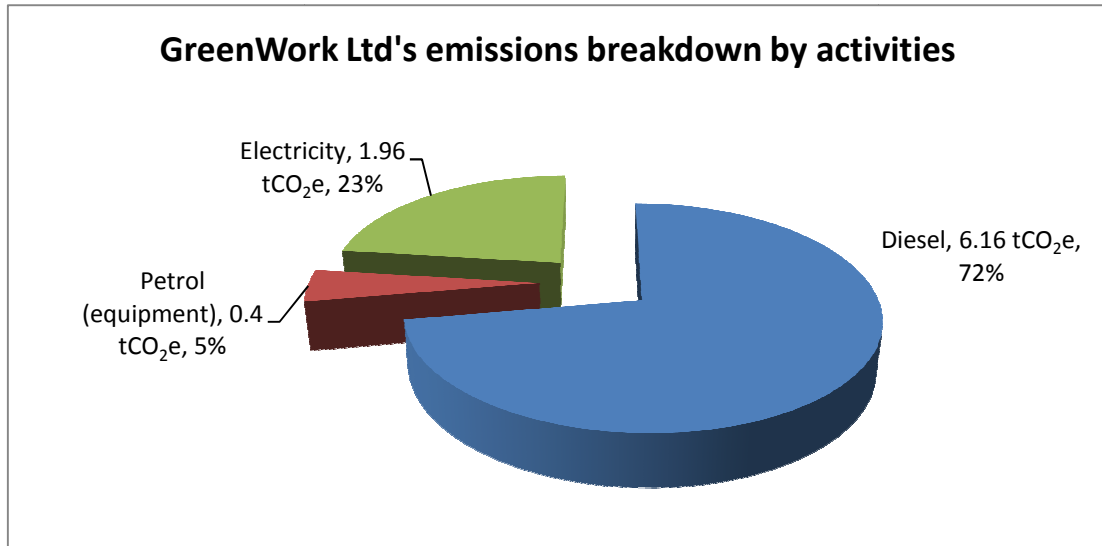
Measurement period – 01/04/2009 to 31/03/2010

GHG emissions source inclusions – The diagram below shows the operational GHG emissions for GreenWork Ltd by emissions source. Total emissions for this period were 8.85 tonnes carbon dioxide equivalents (tCO₂e). The breakdown for the total emissions by Scope was Scope 1: 6.89 tCO₂e; Scope 2: 1.96 tCO₂e and Scope 3: 0 tCO₂e.

GHG emissions source exclusions – Waste to landfill was excluded as these emissions were demonstrated to be *de minimis*.

GHG emissions reduction commitments – GreenWork Ltd has developed the following emissions management goals:

Reduce fuel consumption per employee by 5% - Target 01/09/2010:

1. Car pool when possible
2. Use Skype or telephone for weekly meeting.
3. Improve job planning and transport logistics.
4. Keep vehicles well maintained - empty loads as early as possible, engines serviced, tyres pumped to optimal levels.
5. Drive sensibly - Even, smooth acceleration.

Reduce office power consumption by 5% - Target 31 March 2011:

1. Turn off appliances at wall when not in use.
2. Look in to solar water heating options.

Offset – 9 tonnes CO₂e. AAUs² from Trustpower Hydro projects created under the New Zealand Government's PRE³ above scheme. Serial numbers 501714-501722 have been cancelled (or equivalent) on the carboNZero registry.
