Introduction¹ – Hunter's Wines was established by Irishman, the late Ernie Hunter in 1979. Hunter's is one of New Zealand's best known wineries and a pioneer of the Marlborough wine industry. Led by the 'First lady of New Zealand wine' Jane Hunter, CNZM; O.B.E, Hunter's Wines have the reputation of consistently producing the highest quality wines year after year. Getting quality fruit from our vineyards is a very important step in the process, so everything we do is designed to protect the environment in which our grapes grow, in turn making our wine for you to drink. We understand the need to protect the environment for long-term sustainability and to maintain the stunning environment that we call home. Gaining CEMARS certification under the carboNZero programme is another great step to sustainability and improving the environment we live work and play in for the many generations to come.

Hunter's Wines (NZ) Ltd is accredited through Sustainable Winegrowers New Zealand (SWNZ), and contributes significantly to the Natural Habitat Restoration for the Wairau Plains programme.

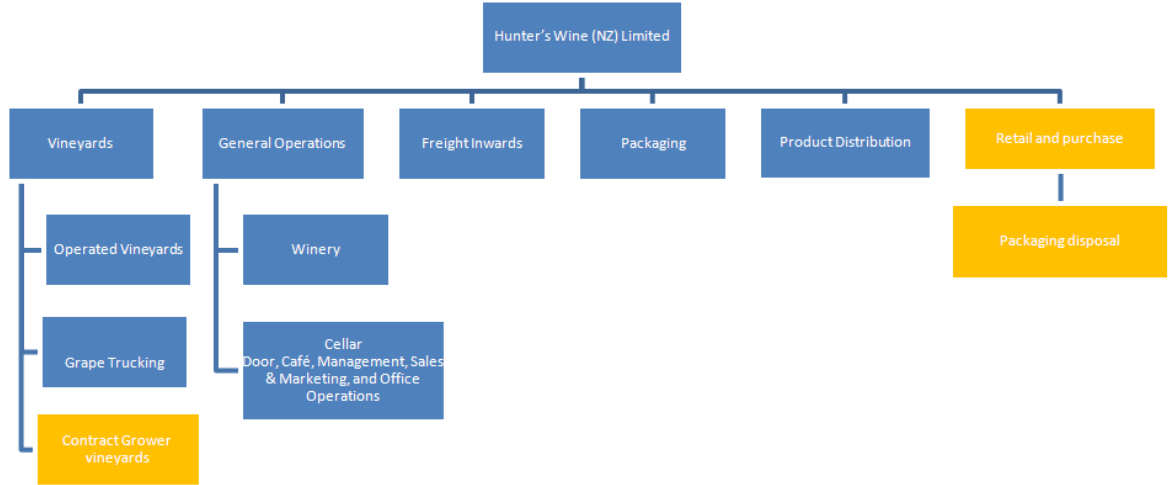


Figure 1: Organisational structure showing business units included and excluded.

Base year – 01/07/2009 to 30/06/2010

Measurement period – 01/07/2010 to 30/06/2011

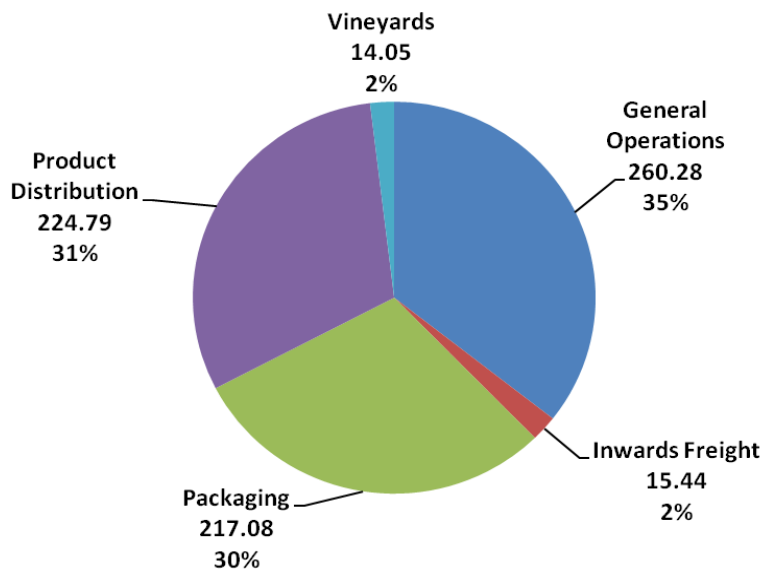


Figure 2: GHG emissions by emissions source.

Emissions source inclusions – The operational GHG emissions for the organisation by emissions source are shown in Figure 2 below.

Emissions as tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalents (tCO₂e) for this period were:

Scope 1: 35.34 tCO₂e
Scope 2: 51.15 tCO₂e
Scope 3: 645.15 tCO₂e
Total: 731.65 tCO₂e

Emissions source exclusions – The following emissions sources were excluded from the inventory for this measurement period:

- GHG emissions associated with the inwards goods supplied to the cafe and the winery, contract growers, hotel stays, third party packaging have been excluded due to estimated emissions being below the *de minimis*.

Emissions reduction commitments – A GHG emissions management plan and reduction targets have been developed.

- to reduce the weight of glass bottles and other packaging components
- to reduce electricity consumption, to be achieved by various actions
- to reduce diesel consumption at vineyards by more efficient use of machinery

Emissions reductions summary against last year's plan – This is the second year reporting under CEAMRS, an absolute reduction of 60 tCO₂e (7.6%) has been achieved.
